SWEETHEART TRIFLE---- Marilyn Perry

1 pkg.(18-1/4 oz.) chocolate cake mix

1 12 oz. pkg. chocolate chips

4-1/4 cups cold milk, divided

1/2 cup heavy whipping cream

1/4 tesp. vanilla extract

2 pkgs.(5.9 oz) instant chocolate. pudding

1 carton (12 oz.) cool whip, thawed

4 Nestle Crunch candy bars crumbled

1. Prepare cake according to package directions. Pour batter into a greased 9x13 pan. bake 30 to 35 min. and let cool

2. In a heavy sauce pan combine chocolate chips 1/4 cup milk and cream Cook and stir over low heat until chips are melted. Remove from heat and stir in vanilla. Cool to room temperature.

3. In a large bowl whisk the 4 cups of milk and pudding for 2 minutes.

let set for 2 minutes until soft set.

4. To assemble, crumble half the cake into a 4-qt. trifle bowl or large bowl.

Layer half the chocolate sauce, pudding, cool whip and candy bars.

Repeat the layers, cover and refrigerate for at least 3 hrs.

Hunting News in your Future:

Turkey Seasons will open March 26th, now is the time to do your pre-season scouting. Following the general spring turkey season will be another couple of weeks when you will be able to harvest bearded birds with your archery equipment only.

During your time in the outdoors hunting turkeys, DFG should have published our 2011 Mammal and Fur bearers regulations and drawing information. So each of us are able to purchase our new Hunting Licenses for 2011 and tag applications of each specie we desire to hunt this summer, fall and winter in California. Remember your applications will need to be mailed in May.

Also this year DFG will finally after several years of promises get their Automated License Purchase System in operation for Fishing & Hunting Licenses. Please do not wait until deadline dates or the day you desire to fish or hunt to learn how this new system is going to work.

It is a computer, and all should know after we have lived with them for several years now. They have a mind of their own, and sometimes cause many heartaches.

Also this year I believe is a year the Department and Commission are able to establish new seasons or regulations thus be sure to check for new regulations and or seasons. At our Hunter Education Conference which updates H.Ed. Instructors of new changes Instructors were informed that it is not whether or not California will have Bowhunter Education required, but when. So we were told individual bowhunters have since 2007 proposed the IBEP become mandatory for California like some of our other states. So if you bowhunt and do not possess an IBEP certificate, my advise would be attend a class in the near future. Presently there are very few Bowhunter Ed classes held in California, because for the past several years only people attending a class are new bowhunters who purchase their equipment from a dealer who recommends attending a class. Or a person whom desires to hunt in Alaska, Idaho, Montana, N. or S. Dakota, Nebraska, or another state which require a certificate for Bowhunting.
