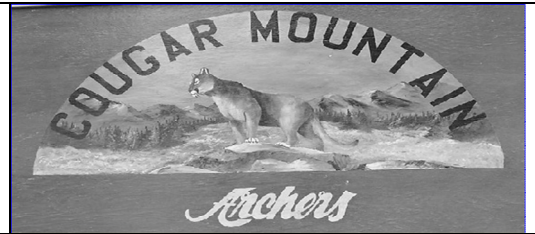

Unfinished Business:

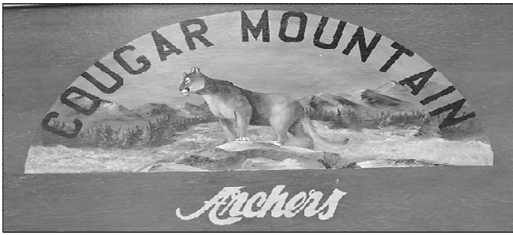
1. Nothing new to report on the cardboard.
