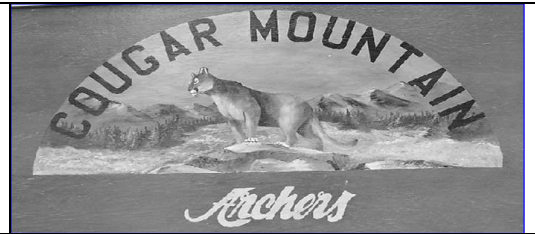

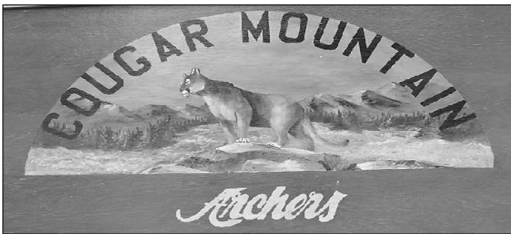

Legislative Information: Joe Becker

May is the month that Fish & Wildlife should be mailing out the 2017-18 Big Game Hunting Booklets, and it becomes the time prior to application deadlines first part of June when every one desiring a certain hunting zone for deer, and any of the other big game specie applications, must be mailed to Sacramento for the drawings. Presently all I have heard concerning this years seasons is most will be similar to last years with only date and tag number changes. Every one who purchased a hunting license in California I believe should be mailed this years booklet, if you are a new California hunter, you must begin the automated process and purchase your license, and check with license agents until you locate a booklet, or use your computer internet for reading all the booklet on internet, then pick your choices and print out required information for applying for your picks of hunts you desire.

Use of dogs in hunting may change this year, also management of predators could be changed this year, so prior to each of us going afield or if hunting another state be sure to get a copy of the current hunting regulations and read all the information. Please be a responsible hunter for bowhunting or firearm depending on seasons and equipment choices. Lastly good luck on all hunt applications then have a great hunt with family and/or friends. Take photos of you, equipment and tagged animal in a life like natural scene. Write a story of hunt and mail it in this fall. Thank you.
